There is a story that goes with these stones:
In 1994 I found this cemetery after about 2 years search, there were no markers in place. I asked Mrs. Loeke owner of the property where the graves were. In her vegetable garden she stated and she showed me the approximate location. She told me that the man who plowed her garden got tired of hitting the stones, took them up and threw them over the fence into the cow pasture. I found them mostly covered with dirt, briars, small bushes & whatever. After a hours work I got to them, another hours work I had them cleaned off best I could & placing them together I could read all word & numbers, some weeks later my son Ed & I went back & took the stones to a car wash & cleaned them & repaired best we could. Mrs. Loeke showed us where to set them.
I believe there are at least 3 more graves there. I only Samuel & Amanda (Lee) Webb - Mrs. & Mr. John Lee & a 13 year old girl, a granddaughter of the Lees. My plan is to verify this as soon as I can. Then build a fence around the grave yard. Reason for this - TN law concerning grave yards are that if not taken care of, they can be destroyed.
