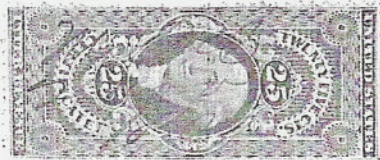


KNOW ALL MEN, That we, *M. J. Cook & G. W. Edwards*

*Dollars*, to which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind our heirs, executors  
and administrators, and each and every one of us, and them, both jointly and severally,  
firmly by these Presents.

Witness our hands and seals, the *2* day of *Nov* 186*7*.

The condition of the above obligation is such, That Whereas *M. J. Cook*  
*Cook* hath prayed and obtained a License to marry *L. M. Zeeb*  
*Zeeb* - Now, if the said *L. M. Zeeb* be an actual  
resident in the County aforesaid, and there shall not hereafter appear any lawful cause  
why the said *M. J. Cook* and *L. M. Zeeb*  
should not be joined together in Holy Matrimony, as Husband and Wife, then this  
obligation to be void and of no effect: otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
