There are some murky beginnings for the line, apparently tracing to Tazewell County, VA. I will abstract some of the book that I wrote on the line and give the facts and level of certainty to those facts that I have been able to dig out. Daniel WEBB, my great grandfather, was only 6 when his father died, and he claimed to remember that Jacob was born 24 March 1807 in Tazewell County and that he had a brother John and a sister Nancy. I think that Daniel's older sister, Sarah, was the source of this information, but she was only fourteen when Jacob died. Daniel was adopted by his sister and they moved to Minnesota in 1865.

I'm just not familiar with the line of WEBBs that you connect to. There was nothing that suggested that my WEBB line had any connection with Tennessee, so I never loved at those WEBB lines. Franklin County borders Alabama and is a long way from Kentucky, where the first clear unambiguous evidence exists for my line. But DNA does not lie, and it seems that I need to investigate much more fully!

I live in Houston, TX. The last couple of weeks have been pretty chaotic for me, but I am getting back into the swing of things.
