

A FATAL ACCIDENT.

Charles Reed Dies From Wounds Received in a Saw Mill.

Clarksville, December 20.—News of the horrible death of Charles Reed, a saw-mill hand, in District Eighteen of Robertson County, has been received here. He was employed to turn logs on the carriage. The belt that runs the carriage became slack and the engineer was signaled to stop the machinery while the belt was being adjusted. In order to fix the belt Reed stepped over the circular saw, which was still in motion, but did not lift his foot high enough. The saw struck the foot between the great toe and next toe and slit the foot to the ankle. Reed then fell upon the saw. The right arm was cut off just above the wrist and the left arm lacerated in a fearful manner. Medical aid was summoned, but Reed died in a few hours after the accident.
