RED OAK — Services for Mrs. Emma Noren, 97, were to be held at 2 p.m. Friday at the First Covenant Church here. She died Tuesday at her Red Oak home after eight years of ill health.

Mrs. Noren was a native of Sweden and a resident of Montgomery County since 1900.

She came to this country at the age of 5 and settled with her family at Charitan. Mrs. Noren had lived here since 1927. She was a former dressmaker.

Mrs. Noran was the first woman to cast a vote in Frankfort Township.

Surviving are five daughters, Elvera and Irene, both of Red Oak; Emma, Topeka, Kan.; Margaret of Chicago and Mrs. Ida Swenson, Fresno, Calif.; two sons, Herbert of Hawthorne, Calif., and David of Oberlin, Kan.; 17 grandchildren, 16 great grand children and 4 great-great grandchildren.

Burial was to be in Mission Cemetery at Stanton.
