

Sven Larson Dies At Sturgeon Bay

STURGEON BAY, Wis.—Sven Larson, 86, this city, died at a local hospital Thursday morning from a complication of ailments incidental to old age. Funeral services will be held at the Stephenson Funeral home at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon with the Rev. Edward F. Helmich officiating. Burial will be in the Jacksonport cemetery.

Larson was born March 27, 1855, in Sweden and came to this country with his first wife, the former Christine Pearson, in 1880. They stayed for a short time in Pennsylvania and then came to Jacksonport where they bought a farm. The first wife died in 1899 and in 1916 he married Christine Leasgreen in Ephraim. He lived in Jacksonport for 55 years when he retired and came to Sturgeon Bay. He served several years as assessor for the town of Jacksonport and was also on the school board. Mrs. Larson survives with one daughter of the first marriage, Mrs. Gustaf Markett of Jacksonport.
