

DOUBLE FUNERAL HELD FOR FLOOD VICTIMS

Double funeral services were held at noon Saturday at Wadlows' Mortuary in Lincoln for John S. Wagner, 47, and his wife, Yvonne Pearl Wagner, 28. Mr. and Mrs. Wagner lost their lives in the flash flood on Monday evening of last week while enroute from Crete to Lincoln. They were found near Highway 77, about seven miles south of Lincoln.
