

**Minna Folsom,  
Descendant of  
Pioneers, Dies**

BERKELEY, Sept. 29 — Mrs. Minna Tanner Folsom, 79, member of a pioneer California family which settled at Murphys (Calaveras County) more than 100 years ago, died yesterday after an illness of several months.

Mrs. Folsom was born in Murphys, where her grandfather, the late Ormund Tanner, held a large farm acreage and also mined. She was the widow of Perry Ellis Folsom, who operated a furniture store in Stockton.

Mrs. Folsom had been making her home for a number of years with her daughter, Mrs. Madeleine Robinson, wife of L. S. "Bob" Robinson, Berkeley civic leader, at 1949 Yosemite Road. She was a member of the Northbrae Women's Club and Circle A of Northbrae Community Church, Berkeley, and the Semper Fidelis group of the North Congregational Church of Stockton.

Besides Mrs. Robinson, Mrs. Folsom is survived by a brother Amon Tanner of Murphys, and a granddaughter, Patricia Robinson, Berkeley.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11:30 a.m. Monday in the B. C. Wallace Chapel in Stockton.
